

OVERVIEW

- This 5 day course builds on previous experience gained in the rope access environment. It is aimed at persons who require the knowledge and ability to allow them to move into a more supervisory role. The course content is based around the 'Code of practice for the use of rope access methods for industrial purposes', BS 7985 2002, the industry standard. Being delivered by our professional and experienced trainers the course is a mixture of practical and theory, covering subjects from legislation through to the rigging of systems and advance rescue techniques.

COURSE TYPE

- This course will take place both in the classroom and in our training facility or on site. Practical and written tests will confirm the competence level reached at the end of the 5 days.

- Candidates must already hold a Rope Access Operators certificate to standard BS7985 or equivalent. You must be over the age of 18, both medically and physically fit, confident with heights and candidates must provide a doctors certificate.
